3. Upon what terms does Jesus give eternal life? Verse 3.

4. What evidence do we have that Jesus did not regard his mission as a failure and that he died frustrated and disappointed? Verse 4.

5. What glory did Jesus have before with the Father? Verse 5.

6. What reason does Jesus give for granting the petitions offered on the behalf of the disciples? Verse 6.

7. What is the second reason Jesus gives as to why the Father should bless the disciples of the Son? Verses 7-8.

8. What is the third reason Jesus gives for blessing the disciples? Verses 9-10.

9. What is the fourth and last plea on behalf of the disciples? Verse 11.

10. Who is the “son of perdition”? Did he “perish” by irrevocable decree of God or by his own apostasy? Verse 12.

11. For what does Jesus pray for the disciples in some of his last moments before his crucifixion? Verse 13.

12. What additional reason for the Father’s care for the disciples is given here? Verse 14.

13. Why did Jesus want the disciples to be protected, but not removed from the world? Verse 15.

14. What was the disciples' relationship to the world? Verse 16.

15. What does "sanctify" mean and how is sanctification brought about? Verse 17.

16. What was the mission of Christ that is now to be the mission of the disciples? Verse 18.

17. What example did Jesus leave that he now prays for the disciples? Verse 19.

18. Who else does Jesus pray for besides the disciples? Verse 20.

19. What kind of oneness or unity does Jesus pray for? Did Jesus pray in this prayer for you and me? Verse 21.

20. What is the glory of which the Savior speaks? Verse 22.

21. What would be the practical aspects of this unity for which Jesus prays? Verse 23.

22. What is the ultimate reason for Jesus' desire for the disciples to be where he is? Verse 24.

23. How was it that the world did not know the Father but the disciples did? Verse 25.
