20. What do you think caused Jesus to weep when He saw the city? Verses 41-42.
21. What famous catastrophe did Jesus predict in these verses? Verses 43-44.
22. What did Jesus do now that He had done once before? Verse 45.
23. Why did Jesus say the ones who bought and sold had made His Father's house a den of thieves? Verse 46.
24. What kept the Pharisees from trying to kill Jesus? Verses 47-48.
