2. Had the guests previously been invited to the wedding feast of the king’s son? Verses 3-4.
3. Why was the king wroth (angry) and what happened to those who treated his invitation with contempt? Verses 5-7.
4. When the honored guests rejected the invitation, whom did the king invite? Verses 8-10.
5. What excuse did the man give for his failure to have on a wedding garment? Verses 11-12.
6. Who or what is represented by the following in verses 2-14:

7. For what purpose did the Pharisees seek counsel? Verse 15.

8. Why do you think the Pharisees sent their disciples to team up with the Herodians? Verse 16.

11. How did Jesus reply to fully satisfy the Herodians and still please the people by implying the tribute was not lawful? Verses 19-21.

13. What was the outstanding feature of the Sadducees' teaching? Verse 23.

14. What was the purpose behind the question the Sadducees asked? Verses 24-28.

15. Jesus met their argument at its weakest point. What was that? Verses 29-30.

16. State the conclusion to Jesus premises on the resurrection: (Verse 32)

Premise 1: God is the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob;

Premise 2: God is not the God of the dead, but of the living;
